3 Now the boy Samuel was serving the LORD under Eli. The LORD's word was rare at that time, and visions weren't widely known. ² One day Eli, whose eyes had grown so weak he was unable to see, was lying down in his room. ³ God's lamp hadn't gone out yet, and Samuel was lying down in the LORD's temple, where God's chest^[a] was.

(⁷ Now Samuel didn't yet know the LORD, and the LORD's word hadn't yet been revealed to him.)
