

#### Scripture

I must stay in your home today." <sup>6</sup> So Zacchaeus came down at once, happy to welcome Jesus.

We sometimes imagine that we must earn God's love. In the story of Zacchaeus, however, Jesus offered companionship to him even before Zacchaeus made restoration to those he had cheated. Were the good works of Zacchaeus the requirement or the response for receiving the love of Jesus? What makes "grace" grace?
